Protecting stormwater drains

- **DO** store inks, chemicals and other potential pollutants in areas where there is no potential that they may enter the environment if they were to spill or leak.
- **DO** stencil Drains with “Rain Water Only” or “Clean water only” or similar.
- **DO** have a spill kit or appropriate measures in place to contain your largest possible spill.
- **DO NOT** dispose of any hazardous materials down the sink, to open ground or storm water drains. Waste chemicals/solvents should be removed offsite by a licensed waste contractor
- **DO NOT** undertake any work in areas where hazardous materials could enter stormwater drains.
- **DO NOT** store inks, chemicals and other pollutants near stormwater drains.

Solid Waste Management

- To reduce wastes, businesses will need to focus on *waste management* rather than solely on waste disposal.
- Focus on *preventing* and *reducing* rather than on treating and disposing of wastes.
- **Avoid** products that cannot be recycled or reused.
- **Reduce** your use of materials.
- **Reuse** materials wherever possible.
- Send materials off to be **recycled**.

Wastewater Management

- Businesses that discharge wastewater to the sewer should hold an industrial waste permit, issued by the Water Corporation. Ensure you hold the relevant permits, as there are penalties for non-compliance.
- Industrial wastewater should not be discharged into stormwater drains or the open ground.
- New regulations apply to a specific schedule of materials. The following materials are common in the printing industry and cannot be discharged to the sewer:
 - Acid with a pH < 4.0
 - Alkali with a pH > 10.0
 - Silver
 - Organic solvents
- Silver bearing pre-press wastewater cannot be directed to sewer without pre-treatment. It must be directed to a silver recovery unit or stored for collection by a licensed waste contractor.

Environmental Law

- All owners, managers and staff should ensure they are familiar with their environmental requirements and obligations. Everybody associated with a business is responsible for the environmental impacts of that business' operations and ignorance of the law is no defence against fines or prosecution.
